## About Swedish Radia Imaging Center

Swedish Radia Imaging is a comprehensive state-of-the-art diagnostic imaging center managed by Radia, the largest private radiology practice in the Pacific Northwest, in partnership with Swedish Medical Center. Housed within the Swedish Medical Center/Issaquah Campus, this fully-equipped imaging center welcomes outpatients referred by their local physicians as well as serves patients being treated at the new community based freestanding Swedish Emergency Department.

For your convenience, Swedish Radia Imaging Center accepts most insurance plans. If you are unsure about your coverage, please contact your benefit administrator. We provide imaging services to the emergency department 24-hours a day, seven days a week. For outpatient services we offer convenient appointments, including same day scheduling for many exams.

## Patient Instructions (If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us at our direct line (425) 394-0650)

**MRI:** Due to a strong magnetic field, please wear comfortable clothing without metal (zippers, snaps, buttons) if possible. Please remove any metal jewelry before arrival. Please let us know if you have an aneurysm clip or any implantable electronic device in your body such as a cardiac pacemaker, neurostimulator, or inner ear implant. Allow up to 60 minutes for your examination.

**CT:** Please do not eat any solid foods within 4 hours of your examination unless your doctor has told you IV contrast will definitely not be given. If receiving oral contrast for an abdominal/pelvic exam, please arrive 1 hour prior to the exam time to start drinking the oral contrast, or you may pick up the contrast from us the day prior to your exam and begin drinking 1 hour prior to your arrival.

### Ultrasound:

**Abdomen:** Please do not eat or drink anything 8 hours prior to your exam except for water and necessary medications. If you are also having a Pelvic Ultrasound, please follow those directions below as well.

**Kidney & Pelvis:** Please drink four 8 oz. glasses of water 1 hour prior to your appointment and keep your bladder full for your exam (this helps the sonographer better visualize the pelvic organs and bladder).

**Pregnancy:** For pregnancies in the first 14 weeks, please drink four 8 oz. glasses of water 1 hour prior to your appointment and keep your bladder full for your exam. For pregnancies after the first 14 weeks, it is not necessary to have a full bladder for

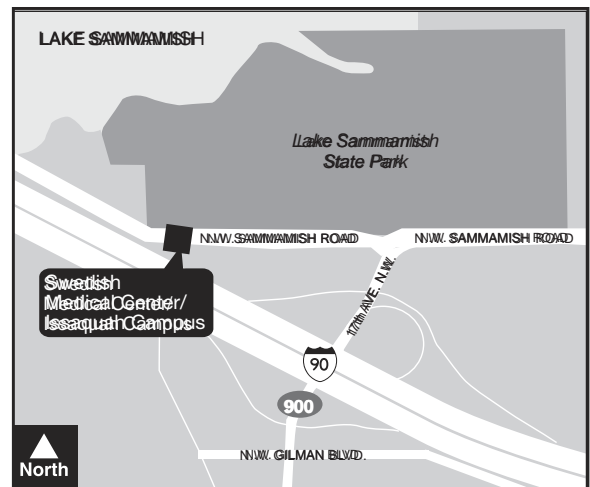
## Directions to Swedish Medical Center/Issaquah Campus

**From the West:** Take I-90 Eastbound to Issaquah, exit 17th Ave. NW, WA-900 (Exit 15) and turn left toward Lake Sammamish State Park.

**From the East:** Take I-90 Westbound to Issaquah, exit 17th Ave. NW, WA-900 (Exit 15) and turn right toward Lake Sammamish State Park.

At the first light, turn left onto NW Sammamish Road. In ½ mile turn left at the blue Swedish Medical Center sign (I-90 Lake Place Center), and the facility will be towards your left. Swedish Radia Imaging Center is on the south side of the building near the freeway. You may park in any stall designated as Swedish Parking.
